### Installation

Add the following to /etc/apt/sources.list **Ubuntu**For Hardy and Newer - version 2.0.12-1 and up

# Remastersys deb http://www.geekconnection.org/remastersys/repository ubuntu/

#### **Debian**

# Remastersys deb http://www.geekconnection.org/remastersys/repository debian/

#### **Both**

\$ sudo apt-get update

\$ sudo apt-get install remastersys

## Running the command

Makes a distribution of software \$ sudo remastersys dist

Make a backup of everything to a livecd \$ sudo remastersys backup

## Burn the image

Burn the iso using your fav. burning program

EG: Brasero

## Other software

UCK does a good job in a different way. Stay tuned.

### VirtualBox

Running it under VirtualBox.

Create a new virtualbox.

Link to the iso image or the burnt CD. Note: iso image will be fast to boot from.

Start the virtualbox and you can install from the resmastersys CD you have created. Make any changes then create another image if you like. This is a great way to create and maintain distros.
